

Guernsey Blue Plaques Nomination Form

Please consult the eligibility criteria before making a nomination.

You may write and support a nomination already received, without needing to complete this form, in which case your letter of support will be considered along with the existing nomination.

A	Name of the Nominated Person ("the nominee") or significant event
B	Other persons to be included on the Plaque
C	Nominee's date of Birth, or date of significant event
D	Nominee's date of Death
E	Address at which the plaque should be erected
F	How is the nominee associated with this address?
G	Are you aware if there have been any discussions with the owner of the property about the possibility of a plaque being erected?
H	Please explain why you feel the nominee or significant event should be considered for a blue plaque. You may do this in a short letter or email, and attach such bibliographic references as you think appropriate.

I	Are you aware of a potential sponsor who can pay the costs of manufacturing this plaque (this could be £500 or more). If you are able to do so, please give details.

Please Note: there are many reasons why a proposal may be rejected, some of which may arise due to personal or confidential information received by the Panel (for example, objections by close living relatives or the owners of the relevant property). If your nominee is selected you may be asked to assist further with the project to research and produce the plaque. The Panel will otherwise not enter into any correspondence over persons rejected or nominated.
