



Risk Assessment for schools – Guernsey Museum at Candie.

This is intended to be a guide only and teachers are strongly recommended to visit the site and conduct their own assessments, based on their students.

Method: Staff Inspection and feedback

Hazards:

1. Slippery surface outside & inside the shop during or after rain – risk of falling or slipping
2. Hot Water Taps in toilets – risk of scalding (teachers, please warn children)
3. Toys on the floor in the Discovery Room – risk of tripping over

Groups at Risk:

1. All visitors– low risk.

Action to be taken:

1. Warn children of slippery outdoor surface and ask them to dry their feet thoroughly on the mat
2. Warn children of the hot water.
3. No running anywhere in the Museum and a warning of toys on the floor
