The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed, and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom *ten* are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship, in the several capacities expressed against their respective names, on a voyage from *London to Punta Arenas and any places on the West Coast of America and the Islands adjacent the North and South Pacific Oceans and the Continent of Europe and back to the Port of final discharge in the United Kingdom. Length of voyage not to exceed eighteen months.*

Provisions issued as per the ‘America’ voyage, 1863-64.

When 2 oz of butter are issued daily the allowance of meat will be 1 lb. No spirits allowed. Equivalent substitutes at the Master’s option.
