# AGREEMENT AND ACCOUNT OF CREW FOREIGN GOING SHIP

### (BARRANCA – 2 SEPTEMBER 1871 – 3 JUNE 1872)

The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed, and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom *eleven* are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship, in the several capacities expressed against their respective names, on a voyage from *London to Punta Arenas and any ports and places on the East and West Coast of South America to and fro as employment may be found for any period not exceeding eighteen months and back to the port of final discharge in the United Kingdom or the Continent of Europe between the Elbe and Brest.* 

Provisions issued as per the 'America' voyage, 1863-64.

When 14 oz of butter is issued weekly the allowance of meat to be 1 lb beef or a 1lb of pork per man per day. No spirits allowed. Equivalent substitutes at the Master's option.

In the event of any member of the crew not being on board at the time stated in this Agreement the Master shall have liberty to engage another in his place at once. The ship shall be considered sufficiently manned with a complement of eighteen hands all told and all above that number extra hands.

In witness whereof the said parties have subscribed their names on the other side or sides hereof on the days against their respective signatures mentioned. Signed by *John H Le Vesconte*, Master, *on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of September 1871*.
