The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed, and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom ten are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship, in the several capacities expressed against their respective names, on a voyage from London to Punta Arenas and/or any port or ports in South and North America, United States of America, North and South Pacific and Atlantic Oceans Indian and China Seas and Straits, Red Sea, Persian Gulf and Japan, Australasian New Zealand and Cape Colonies, West Indies Mediterranean to and fro for a period not to exceed two years, and back to a final port of discharge in the United Kingdom or continent of Europe between the Elbe and Brest.

Provisions issued as per the 'America' voyage, 1863-64.

When 14 oz of butter are issued weekly the allowance of meat to be ½ lb less daily. No spirits allowed. Equivalent substitutes at the Master's option. Swearing is strictly prohibited.
