The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed, and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom *twelve* are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship, in the several capacities expressed against their respective names, on a voyage from *London to Punta Arenas and or any ports or places within the limits of 75 degrees North and 60 degrees South Latitude, the maximum time to be two years trading in any rotation and to end in the United Kingdom.*

Provisions issued as per the 'America' voyage, 1863-64.

In any case an equal quantity of fresh meat or fresh vegetables may at the option of the master be served out in lieu of the salted or tinned meats or preserved or compressed vegetables named in the above scale. No spirits allowed. Substitutes at the Master's option.

The Crew shall be deemed complete with sixteen hands all told, of whom five are sailors.

In witness whereof the said parties have subscribed their names on the other side or sides hereof on the days against their respective signatures mentioned.
