The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed, and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship, in the several capacities expressed against their respective names, on a voyage from *London to Punta Arenas and any other ports or places in the North and south Pacific and Atlantic Oceans, Indian and China Seas and Straits, Cape and Australian Colonies, United States and West Indies [wherever] employment may be found for any period not exceeding two years and back to the port of final discharge of cargo in the United Kingdom or Continent of Europe between the Elbe and Brest.*

Provisions issued as per the 'America' voyage, 1863-64.

When 1 lb of butter is issued weekly the allowance of meat will be 1 lb per man daily. No spirits allowed. Equivalent substitutes at the Master's option.

1 oz of coffee or cocoa or chocolate may be substituted for ¼ oz tea. Molasses for sugar, the quantity to be one half more. 1 lb of potatoes or yams, ½ lb of flour or rice, 1/3 pt of peas, or ¼ pt barley may be substituted for each other. When fresh meat is issued the proportion to be 2 lbs per man per day, in lieu of salt meat, flour, rice and peas. Beef and pork may be substituted each for the other.

The crew shall consist of sixteen hands all told all above that number to be considered extra.
