The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed, and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom --- are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship, in the several capacities expressed against their respective names, on a voyage from *London to Punta Arenas and or any ports and places in the Pacific Oceans, and back to a port of final discharge of cargo in the United Kingdom. The voyage not to exceed eighteen months.*

Provisions issued as per the 'America' voyage, 1863-64.

No spirits allowed. Equivalent substitutes at the Master's option.

1 oz of coffee or cocoa or chocolate may be substituted for ¼ oz tea. Molasses for sugar, the quantity to be one half more. 1 lb of potatoes or yams, ½ lb of flour or rice, 1/3 pt of peas, or ¼ pt barley may be substituted for each other. When fresh meat is issued the proportion to be 2 lbs per man per day, in lieu of salt meat, flour, rice and peas. Beef and pork may be substituted each for the other.
