The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed, and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom five are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship, in the several capacities expressed against their respective names, on a voyage from London to Punta Arenas and any ports and places on the East and West Coast of South America the Indian and China Seas and Straits, Japan, Red Sea, Persian Gulf North and South Pacific and Atlantic Oceans the Cape Australian and New Zealand Colonies the United States of America between Portland and Galveston inclusive, the British North American Province the West Indies and the Mediterranean Sea to and fro as employment may be found for any period not exceeding three years and back to the port of final discharge in the United Kingdom or the Continent of Europe between the Elbe and Brest.

Provisions issued as per the 'America' voyage, 1863-64. Equivalent substitutes at the Master's option. No spirits allowed.

In the event of any member of the crew not being on board at the time stated in this agreement the Master shall have liberty to engage another in his place at once.

In witness whereof the said parties have subscribed their names on the other side or sides hereof on the days against their respective signatures mentioned. Signed by *John Giffard*. Master *on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1871*.
