

AGREEMENT FOR FOREIGN GOING SHIP

(IRAZU – 22 AUGUST 1866 – 7 AUGUST 1867)

The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship in the several capacities expressed against their respective names on a voyage from *Guernsey to the Sandwich Islands via London, thence to a port or ports on the North or South Pacific returning to a port of discharge in the United Kingdom or Continent.*

Provisions issued as per the 'America' voyage, 1863-64.

No liquor will be allowed on board. Butter 1 lb per man weekly. Vinegar and lemon juice as per act. Equivalent substitutes to above at Master's option.
