

AGREEMENT AND ACCOUNT OF CREW
FOREIGN GOING SHIP

(IRAZU – 4 OCTOBER 1867 – 18 JULY 1868)

The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed, and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom *seven* are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship, in the several capacities expressed against their respective names, on a voyage from *London to Pyta and any other places in Peru and on the West and East Coasts of South and North America and the islands adjacent, and back to the port of final discharge of cargo in the United Kingdom or to the Continent of Europe and finally to the United Kingdom. Length of voyage not to exceed two years.*

Provisions issued as per the ‘America’ voyage, 1863-64.

No spirits allowed. Equivalent substitutes at the Master’s option.

1 oz of coffee or cocoa or chocolate may be substituted for ¼ oz tea. Molasses for sugar, the quantity to be one half more. 1 lb of potatoes or yams, ½ lb of flour or rice, 1/3 pt of peas, or ¼ pt barley may be substituted for each other. When fresh meat is issued the proportion to be 2 lbs per man per day, in lieu of salt meat, flour, rice and peas. Beef and pork may be substituted each for the other.
