No spirits allowed. Equivalent substitutes at the Master's option. No swearing allowed.

1 oz of coffee or cocoa or chocolate may be substituted for ½ oz tea. Molasses for sugar, the quantity to be one half more. 1 lb of potatoes or yams, ½ lb of flour or rice, 1/3 pt of peas, or ¼ pt barley may be substituted for each other. When fresh meat is issued the proportion to be 2 lbs per man per day, in lieu of salt meat, flour, rice and peas. Beef and pork may be substituted each for the other.
