The several persons whose names are hereto subscribed, and whose descriptions are contained below, and of whom *ten* are engaged as sailors, hereby agree to serve on board the said ship, in the several capacities expressed against their respective names, on a voyage from *London to Punta Arenas and or any port or ports in the West Coast of North and South America United States of America between Portland and Galveston inclusive Brazil's River Plate West Indies Mediterranean and back to the port of final discharge in the United Kingdom or Continent of Europe between the Elbe and Brest. Voyage not to exceed two years.*

Provisions issued as per the 'America' voyage, 1863-64.

Equivalent substitutes at the Master's option. No spirits allowed. When 14 oz of butter is issued weekly the allowance of meat shall be half a pound less per man per day.

If any person is not on board at the time appointed the Master may engage a substitute at once. Swearing is strictly prohibited.
