In any case an equal quantity of fresh meat or fresh vegetables may at the option of the master, be served out in lieu of the salted or tinned meats or preserved or compressed vegetables named in the above scale. No spirits allowed. Equivalent substitutes at the Master's option. Swearing is strictly forbidden.
