

CASTLE CORNET

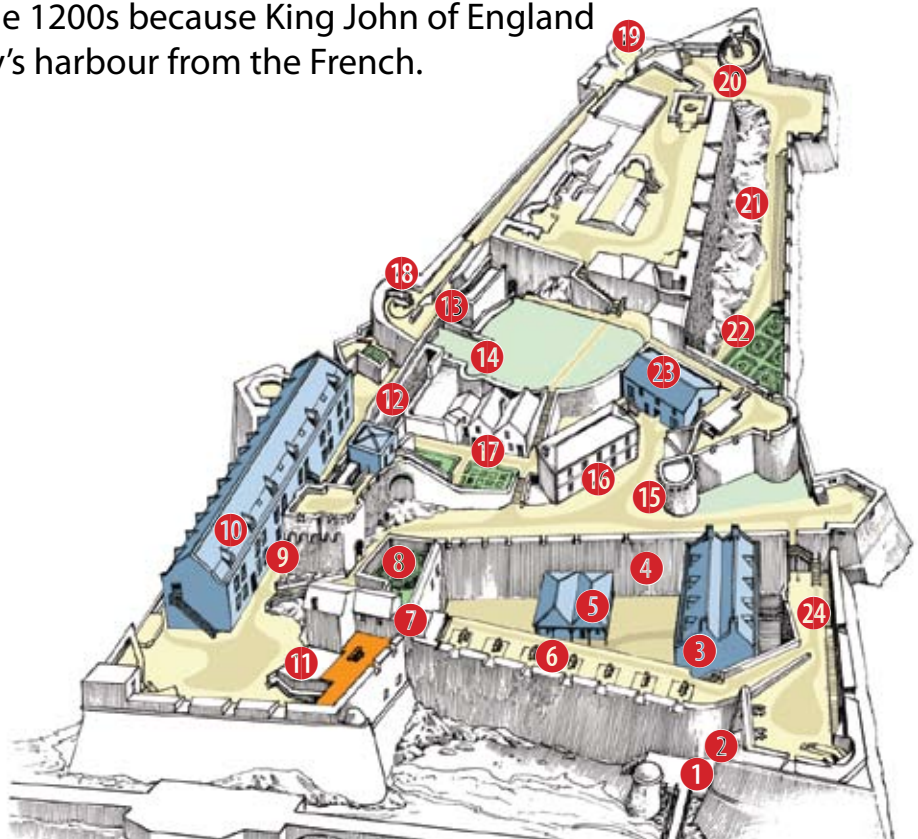
Castle Cornet was built in the 1200s because King John of England needed to protect Guernsey's harbour from the French.

LOOK FOR THE CASTLE TRAIL SIGNS AND FOLLOW THE ROUTE



Start outside where you first came in.

1. The Entrance to the Castle

😊 Queen Elizabeth's Coat of Arms

2. Go through the curved tunnel - GOOD DEFENCE

3. Lower Barracks 😊 a soldier in the first room

4. Bronze Plaques 😊 James de Saumarez' ships

5. Guard House & SHOP 😊 things to buy!

6. Saluting Battery 😊 7 cannons

7. The First Castle 💡 you are attacking it

8. Lambert's Garden 😊 a small cannon or two

9. The Barbican 😊 a trapped mangonel ball



10. Upper Barracks & MARITIME MUSEUM

😊 a Ship's Figurehead

11. Noonday Gun 😊 the GUN

TURN BACK TO THE FIRST CASTLE and go inside the Barbican

12. Prisoner's Walk 😊 the arch where Portcullis were hung

13. Sally Port Steps 🚶 imagine soldiers escaping from here 700 years ago!

**Do NOT go down the steps yet!
Go through the opening on the right.**

14. The remains of the Medieval Chapel and Hall.
🚶 the people who lived there and the Donjon or Keep which blew up in 1672!

TO CONTINUE THE TRAIL GO DOWN THE STEEP STEPS

15. The Gunner's Tower 🚶 a walkway around the top

16. The Hospital Building 😊 the date it was built

17. The Sutler's House 😊 the Kitchen Garden

Go through the opening and down the Sally Port steps

18. Well Battery 😊 the Russian Cannon from the Crimea

19. Well Walk 😊 graffiti left by a German soldier in 1942

20. South Battery 😊 traversing Gun and German lookout

21. Musket Steps 🚶 soldiers in relays firing their guns

22. Governor's Garden 😊 the pattern the plants make

23. Store Building

**GO THROUGH THE TUNNEL
walk past the Gunner's Tower**

GO DOWN THE METAL STAIRCASE PAST THE GREENHOUSE

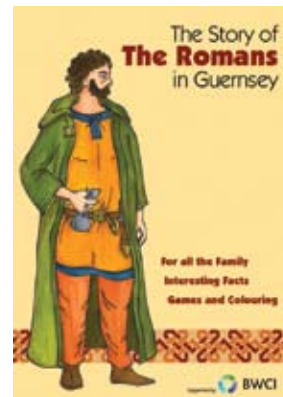
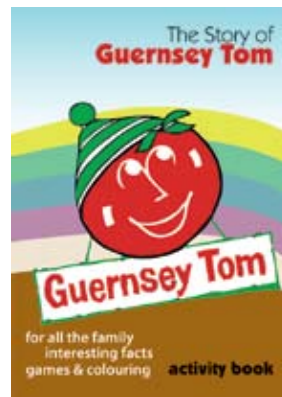
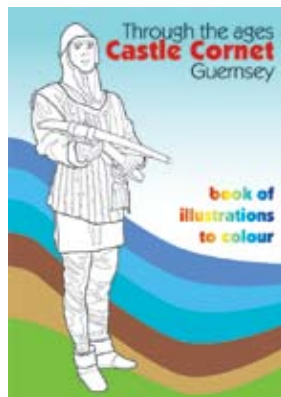
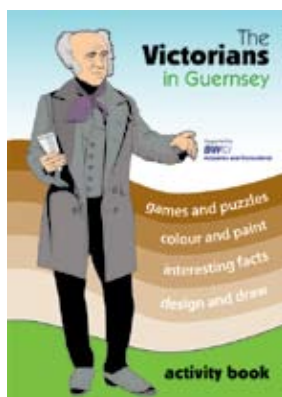
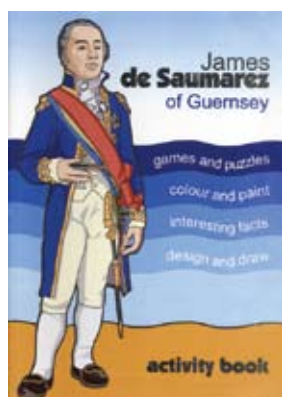
24. Walk along the Town Bastion and back to the entrance.
